All artwork picked up at these sites **MUST** be properly wrapped, boxed or secured upon delivery.

- One entry per category per student.
- Five entries total per category.
- SCISA is **NOT** responsible for damaged pieces.
- The only artwork to be transported by SCISA staff is paintings, drawings, and photography (**NO 3-D or pottery, sculpture, etc.**)
- Lower School art **WILL** be judged.

GUIDELINES, CRITERIA, AND PROCEDURES

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LIMIT: ONE ENTRY PER CATEGORY PER STUDENT

Lower School Division.....Grades 1 – 5
Middle School Division.....Grades 6 – 8
High School Division.....Grades 9 - 12

- **No entries delivered to the ROB will be accepted after 12:00 p.m. on Monday 1/31.**
- Entries will be on display Tuesday, February 1st and Wednesday, February 2nd.
- Each school is responsible for the delivery and pickup of their work.
- The following prizes will be awarded:

1 st Place	Lower School
2 nd Place	Lower School
1 st Place	Middle School
2 nd Place	Middle School
1 st Place	High School
2 nd Place	High School
- Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded at the judges' discretion.
- **All Divisions will be judged.**

1. The submission process will include an early School Registration Form, a Teacher Group Submission Form, and an individual Student Identification Form.
2. The early School Registration form and Group Submission Forms are to be completed and mailed to SCISA along with the \$125 (per school) entry fee.
3. **The Middle School and High School Division ONLY will submit a brief Artist Statement (limited to 100 typed or less). These statements must accompany and be attached to the front of each piece. Pieces without statements will not be judged.**
4. 2D entries must be matted or mounted on paper of at least poster board weight with black or white matting.
5. **NO FRAMED ARTWORK WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
6. Any two-dimensional medium (such as chalk, tempera, watercolor, oil, acrylic, photography, printmaking, graphic design, digital media, collage, fiber, weaving, relief, stained glass, open or 2D mixed media is acceptable.) Chalk entries are to be sprayed or covered. Two-dimensional and/or relief style entries will be no thicker than ½ inch. The entire piece must be flat and stackable.
7. Any three-dimensional medium (such as pottery, sculpture, open or 3D mixed media is acceptable.)
8. Schools will be assigned an identification number. This number should be put on a small sticker and placed on the front of each piece of artwork. This should make identifying and picking up your school's artwork after the show much easier.
9. The Student Art Show Identification Form must be photocopied, **completed in its entirety** and attached to the back of each 2D entry and bottom of each 3D entry. Artwork submitted without the ID form will not be accepted, judged, or displayed. This page is NOT the registration form.
10. A school may submit one entry per student in each category in their division.
11. All artwork should be current and completed since last year's SCISA Art Show and not previously entered in a SCISA Student Art Show.
12. Entries will be judged on creativity, originality, imagination, color, composition, and technique. All entries must be original works. No paint-by-number work or kit projects will be accepted. Copyrighted work (e.g., Disney characters, etc.) will not be accepted. The artwork should not infringe upon any third-party proprietary rights and must not violate any intellectual property laws. An entry that has been copied from an existing photo (not the artist's own), painting, graphic, advertisement, or any other work produced by another person is not eligible.
13. All art entries must be claimed and removed from the exhibit area following the Awards Ceremony on Wednesday, February 2nd at 2:00 pm. **NO ARTWORK MAY BE REMOVED PRIOR TO OR DURING THE AWARDS CEREMONY. SCISA is not responsible for unclaimed pieces.**
14. The Art Show competition has made an effort to comply with the NAEA policy on contest and competitions for young children.
