



SCISA CHESS RULES & INFORMATION

- This is not a ranked tournament.
- Schools are not limited in the number of participants they may send – Duplicate this form as needed.
- A coaches meeting will be held prior to the event. At that time absent contestants will be “scratched”.
- Please plan to stay until the end of the tournament which may last past 2:30, depending on the number of participants
- **No changes – Deletions ONLY!**
- Trophies will be awarded to the top three individuals and teams.
- Teams will be made of three or more players from the same school.
- The trophies will be awarded based on the percentage of points won from all games played by the entire team.
- Games that match teammate against teammate will not be counted toward team results but will be counted in individual results.
- Lunch will be provided.
- Schools must bring their own boards and at least one timer (chess clock) per two players.
- Interested coaches and/or adult supervisors may act as directors of the morning phase of the competition and should contact the SCISA office immediately if you are able to serve in this capacity.
